
Early next morning, she woke to the sound of a loud whistle. She dressed quickly and climbed down the ladder. A boy was standing outside the door with a flock of goats.


"This is Peter, the goat boy," said Grandfather. "Will you go up the mountain with him?"



He didn't change his mind. <sup>2</sup>


