2. Plot

Born in Greenbow, Alabama, Forrest Gump's IQ is only 75. His mother always tries to make him feel no different from anybody else. Jenny is a motherless girl, whose father is an alcoholic. Forrest and Jenny are best friends like peas and carrots.

Forrest gains a lot during his life. He runs very fast, so he enters the college, and later he joins the football team in the college. Years later, with his college degree, he is recruited in the army. In the army, he meets Bubba, another important friend in his life. Bubba is always talking about shrimps. 1. Cultural Notes

1) Ku Klux Klan

Ku Klux Klan is short for 3K Club, which was formed in 1865 in Tennessee, with a Confederate General Nathan Bedford as the leader. The club advocated white superiority. They use violent means to prevent the blacks from gaining any rights after the Civil War.

2) Elvis Aaron Presley

Elvis Aaron Presley was a very popular singer in the mid-1950s. The Rolling Stone Magazine said that he made rock and roll the international language of the pop. He defined the music genre of rock and roll and had an extensive impact on culture. He was a music giant who changed the

development of music. His music was under the influence of African-American blues, Christian gospel and so on. His dance moves, clothing and even attitude towards life was followed by music enthusiasts.

3) John Lennon

If you are not familiar with the name John Lennon, you may know the famous rock music band Beetles. And John Lennon is one of its founders. He was an English musician, songwriter, singer and political activist.

In 1952, John Lennon began to like music after entering Quarry Bank primary school. In 1955, he organized a rock band called "Quarrymen" at the school. After the Beetles period, he became a famous solo singer. Many of his famous songs, including *Give Peace a Chance* and *Imagine*, were issued in that period.

But in 1980, John was shot to death by one of his fans out of his apartment in Manhattan. It made people begin to reflect on a social phenomenon that the fans were so crazy to the music and musician beyond the artistic extent. It had opened out the problems of the American society.

4) Ping-pong Diplomacy

In April 1971, at the 31st World Table Tennis Championships held in Japan, the US national table tennis team expressed the idea to visit China.

In response, the Chinese Table Tennis Association invited the US table tennis team to visit China. Premier Zhou Enlai met with the US table tennis delegation headed by Nixon.

Premier Zhou said: "By visiting our country, you have opened the gate of the exchanges between the people of us two nations. We believe that a friendly exchange will win approval and support from both the Chinese and American peoples."

5) Watergate Scandal

It is a political scandal of the Republican administration occurring in Watergate Hotel in 1972 when President Nixon engaged in the president election campaign.

Story comes that Nixon appointed five men to break into the DNC headquarters at the Watergate hotel to wire some bugs for listening secretly to the process about the election in the Democratic Party. The scandal made Nixon a focus in American society and left him with great pressure. It didn't influence Nixon's reappointment in that year, but with pressure, he had to admit it and resigned in 1974, which made Nixon the first president to leave his office because of the scandal in American history.

3. Film Review

Forrest Gump was born with an IQ of 75, a bit on the slow side, and he has some muscle problems. Why can he become a football star, a Vietnam battlefield hero, a shrimp boat captain, and finally a millionaire? After watching the film I wonder why he can achieve so much success that many people dream of. Many people may ask about Forrest's success, which is actually one of the themes of this film. We can analyze the film with the following aspects:

3.1 Mrs. Gump playing an important role in Forrest's life

Mrs. Gump is a great mother. Her influence on Forrest is irreplaceable. Just because of Mrs. Gump's loving for life, she tries her best to make Forrest feel no different from others. Though she knew her son's IQ is only 75, she still tries her best to let Forrest enter the famous public school to obtain good education. She always encourages him, which is the main reason for Forrest's success.

Mrs. Gump is an anchor for Forrest. Before leaving for Vietnam when saying goodbye to each other, they sit on the rock outside their house, leaning together, and finally Forrest can't help shedding tears in his mother's arms.

From what Forrest said, we can know the great influence of his mother on him. For example, "Mama always had a way of explaining things so I could understand them easily" as well as "stupid is as stupid does".

Before she went to the last part of her life, Mrs. Gump told Forrest that "I didn't know it, but I was destined to be you mama. I did the best I could. I happen to believe that you make your own destiny. You have to do the best with what God gave you". She told him again that "Life was like a box of chocolates and you never know what you are going to get". What his mother said was meaningful, which helps him guide his life.

So after his long running he may remember his mother's words — you get to put the past behind you before you move on. He says he was tired, but mostly he knew what to do with his mother's words.

3.2 Forrest judging from his own

3.2.1 Insistence

Insistence is an important word in the film. Most of us may be smarter than Forrest, but not all of us can focus on one thing constantly. Usually, we can't do one thing till the last moment, so we fail. Forrest always knows his own shortcomings, so he focuses and finally he succeeds.
