Obtaining Conference Information


Learning Objectives

As an academic researcher, it is important to participate in the international academic conference to keep yourself informed of the latest development in your field, get acquainted with other experts and scholars, and obtain more opportunities to communicate and cooperate with them, which will broaden your eyesight and improve your academic studies.

This book is designed to help you prepare for attending a conference and understand a variety of knowledge and techniques for performing well. With the practical knowledge and useful skills provided in this book, you can become more successful in attending international conferences.

This chapter will introduce different meetings and how to obtain conference information.



Nowadays, there are thousands of international meetings held worldwide every year. Different meetings are organized by different sponsors and organizers in different modes for different purposes. Each type requires a different structure and supports a different number of participants. These meetings can be generally differentiated as follows.

1.1.1 Meeting

"Meeting" is a general term of a formal or informal deliberative assembly of individuals called to debate certain issues and problems, and to make decisions. Since the definition of meeting is rather extensive, it can mean any kind of gathering, formal or informal; the time can be long or short; the scale, large or small; the participants, many or a few.

1.1.2 Conference

Conference is a kind of formal prearranged meeting for consultation, exchange of information, or discussion, often lasting for a few days. An academic conference is a conference for researcheres to present and discuss their work, which provides an important channel for exchange of information between researchers. The international conference means a meeting held at the international level, with the participants coming from different countries.

1.1.3 Symposium

Symposium refers to the meeting for specialized academic discussion, at which experts,

scholars, and other participants of a particular field discuss a particular subject. Compared with a conference, a symposium is usually narrower and more specific in the range of topics. In terms of scale, a symposium may be smaller than a conference, because sometimes several symposiums may be held simultaneously in a conference.

1.1.4 Convention

Convention, in the sense of a meeting, is a kind of routine meeting, such as the annual convention, biannual convention, or biennial convention, at which a group of individuals meet at an arranged place and time in order to discuss or engage in some common interest. Usually it is regularly organized by a learned society, a professional association, an academic institution, etc.

1.1.5 Forum

Forum is in fact a kind of public meeting or assembly involving an open discussion of subjects of public interest and often including the audience's participation. People exchange ideas and discuss issues, especially important public issues.

1.1.6 Seminar


Seminar is usually a class in a college or university, or is a formal meeting, where participants study under a professor with each doing original research and all exchanging results through reports and discussions. In a seminar, the presentations are mainly given by chief speakers, while other people first listen and then join them.

1.1.7 Workshop

Workshop originally means a room, a group of rooms, or a building in which goods are manufactured or repaired. Regarding meeting, it usually refers to intensive educational program, discussion group, or the like, in which people engage in intensive discussion and activity on a particular subject or project, and it emphasizes exchange of ideas, the demonstration and application of techniques and skills, etc.

1.1.8 Colloquium

Colloquium is usually an academic meeting at which specialists deliver addresses on a topic or on related topics and then answer questions relating to them. Participants of the colloquium will express their opinions around a specific topic formally. Apart from the meetings above, there are also other forms of meetings, such as summit, roundtable, congress and so on, which will not be detailed one by one here.



Nowadays, different channels can be used to acquire conference information, such as the Internet, membership of professional organizations, professional journals and so on. The following are some useful sources for searching or learning more about international conferences.

1.2.1 The Internet

We live in the information age, so the Internet is a popular source of information. Search engines are the best tools to use when you look for a specific meeting or possible conferences to be held in your field.

When you search for a specific meeting, the name of the meeting may be taken as the keyword; if you search for some forthcoming conferences, the keywords should describe your research, such as "cognitive linguistics", "English literature", or "civil engineering", and include such terms as "conference", "convention", "symposium", "call for papers", etc. Or you may specify a certain year, such as 2019, in order to find the conferences to be held in the specific year.

Besides, some conference websites provide an amount of conference information in nearly all fields. You can register the website to customize your interested conferences. The following are some commonly-used conference websites:

Conferences held or to be held both domestically and abroad are available on this website. You may register via your e-mail and specify some interested subject categories so that once you visit the website, the related conference information will be provided.

Conference Notice and Call for Conference Papers

Learning Objectives

- To understand the format of conference notice and call for conference papers;
- 2. To learn to locate important conference information.



A conference notice is helpful for the prospective participants to acquire general information about the conference. It should provide all the necessary conference information as much as possible, which usually includes the name of the conference, the date and the place, the organizer, the purpose, the key topics, prospective participants, ways to register, registration fees, the conference agenda, the contact channels and so on. A conference notice may take the form of memo, letter, e-mail, public notice, or poster, which gives all the information in written form to prepare for the meeting, similar to an invitation to an event.

As for the format of conference notice, variations may exist, but the following items are usually included:

- Theme (aim, background);
- Participants invited;
- Application qualifications;
- Applicants' responsibility;
- Organizer;
- Registration;
- Reception;
- Notification of acceptance;
- Hospitality.

A call for conference papers is written to notify the prospective participants of more specific information about the conference. Like a conference notice, a call for papers also includes information concerning the name, date, place, sponsors, and purposes of the conference; but a call for papers is mainly characterized by more detailed information about

the conference scope (theme), conference areas (topics of interest), other activities held during the conference, such as workshop, tutorials, special sessions, etc., keynote speakers, specific requirements for paper submission, publications, important dates, ways to contact the secretariat of the conference, different chairs, members of program committee and so on. In a word, information carried in a call for papers of a conference is usually more detailed and complete than that in a conference notice.

The format of call for conference papers is as follows:

- Theme and/or background;
- Conference objectives;
- Topics to be discussed;
- Time and venue;
- Papers and submissions;
- Organizing institution and committee;
- Contact information.

Here are two samples for call for conference papers.

Sample 1

ICML 2018 Call for Papers

The 35th International Conference on Machine Learning (ICML 2018) will be held in Stockholm, Sweden from July 10 to 15, 2018. The conference will consist of one day of tutorials (July 10), followed by three days of main conference sessions (July 11–13) and two days of workshops (July 14–15). We invite submissions of papers on all topics related to machine learning for the conference proceedings, and proposals for tutorials and workshops.

This year, ICML will adopt a **single reviewing cycle**, with a single paper deadline on **February 9, 2018, 23:59 Universal Time (3:59 p.m. Pacific Daylight Time)**.

Submissions will open on January 9, 2018 and are managed through CMT: https:// cmt.research.microsoft.com/ICML2018/Default.aspx.

Submitted papers can be up to **eight pages** long, not including references, and up to ten pages when references and acknowledgments are included. Any paper exceeding this length will automatically be rejected. Authors have the option of submitting a supplementary file containing further details of their work; it is entirely up to the reviewers to decide whether they wish to consult this additional material. The supplementary material must be submitted as a zip file, even if it only contains a single PDF document.

All submissions must be electronic, **anonymous** and must closely follow the formatting guidelines in the templates; otherwise they will automatically be rejected.

★ Dual submission policy

It is not appropriate to submit papers that are identical (or substantially similar) to versions that have been previously published, or accepted for publication, or that have been submitted in parallel to other conferences. Such submissions violate our dual submission policy.

There are several exceptions to this rule:

- Submission is permitted of a short version of a paper that has been submitted to a journal, but has not yet been published in that journal. Authors must declare such dual-submissions either through the CMT submission form, or via e-mail to the program chairs (icml2018pc@gmail.com). It is the author's responsibility to make sure that the journal in question allows dual concurrent submissions to conferences.
- Submission is permitted for papers presented or to be presented at conferences or workshops without proceedings (e.g. ICML or NIPS workshops), or with only abstracts published.
- Submission is permitted for papers that are available as a technical report (or similar, e.g. in arXiv). In this case, we suggest the authors not cite the report, so as to preserve anonymity.

Finally, note that previously published papers with substantial overlap written by the authors must be cited in such a way so as to preserve author anonymity. Differences relative to these earlier papers must be explained in the text of the submission. For example: This work develops our earlier work, which showed that...

★ Reviewing criteria

Accepted papers must contain significant novel results. Results can be either theoretical or empirical. Results will be judged on the degree to which they have been objectively established and/or their potential for scientific and technological impact.

Sample 2

36th International Conference on Consumer Electronics 2018 (ICCE 2018)

The IEEE Consumer Electronics (CE) Society is soliciting technical papers for oral and poster presentations at its 36th annual flagship conference, IEEE International Conference on Consumer Electronics (ICCE) in Las Vegas. ICCE is the established forum for innovative research in all areas of consumer electronics and is co-located with the CTA's Consumer Electronics Show (CES). CES is the world's largest consumer electronics trade-conference.

★ The theme of the ICCE 2018 is "cybersecurity".

Topics consistent with this theme include all aspects of foundation technologies and robust architectures that support privacy, reliability, anti-counterfeiting, authentication, content protection for consumer electronics devices, their networks, and the services connected to these devices.

Paper contributions are sought in but are not limited to the following areas:

- Security and Privacy of CE Hardware and Software Systems (SPC);
- Energy Management of CE Hardware and Software Systems (EMC);
- Application-Specific CE for Smart Cities (SMC);
- RF, Wireless, and Network Technologies (WNT);
- Internet of Things and Internet of Everywhere (IoT);
- Entertainment, Gaming, and Virtual and Augmented Reality (EGV);
- AV Systems, Image and Video, and Cameras and Acquisition (AVS);
- Automotive CE Applications (CEA);
- CE Sensors and MEMS (CSM);
- Consumer Healthcare Systems (CHS);

- Enabling and HCI Technologies (HCI);
- Smartphone and Mobile Device Technologies (MDT);
- Other Technologies Related with CE (MIS).

In addition to regular oral and poster sessions based on the above tracks, ICCE 2018 will have many special sessions on current hot topics related to CE. ICCE 2018 will also feature industry tracks and a student research forum as an integral part. The technical program committee invites proposals for special sessions, industry tracks, and expert panels. These proposals as well as the student research forum papers can be submitted at the following link.

Authors are invited to submit original, unpublished manuscripts of 2- to 6-page length at https://edas.info/showConferenceDetails.php?c=23404. Previously published papers or papers under review for other conferences/journals should not be submitted for consideration.

Authors may prepare original work of maximum 6 pages with an 200-word abstract using double-column IEEE conference-format template at http://www.ieee.org/ conferences_events/conferences/publishing/templates.html.

All accepted papers (including regular papers, special session papers, and SRF papers) will be published in the *ICCE 2018 Digest* or *Proceedings* and submitted to IEEE Xplore. Instructions for authors and document templates are available on the conference website. A selected set of papers from ICCE 2018 program will be invited for submission to special issues of peer-reviewed journals (e.g. *CE Magazine/Transactions*) based on reviewers' feedback and quality of conference presentation.
