When it was introduced in September 2021, an Apple (4) _____ (represent) told *BBC News*: "We remain concerned that strict regulation mandating (强制执行) just one type of connector stifles (抑制) innovation rather than encouraging it, (5) _____ in turn will harm consumers in Europe and around the world."

Lightning to USB-C adaptors are already available from other electronics brands including Amazon, and all

iPhones since the iPhone 8 which launched in 2017 (6) _____(support) wireless charging.

As the current iPhone 14 now looks to be the last Apple device to exclusively (专门地) use it, this could mark the (7) _____(begin) of the end of the Lightning cable. However, it is still unclear (8) _____ this will be a global change to the product.

The EU common-charger rule covers a range of "small and medium-sized portable (便携式) electronics", according to the EU. Any of these devices (9) _____(charge) using a wired cable will have to have a USB Type-C port, regardless (10) _____ who makes the devices.

Professors Katalin Kariko and Drew Weissman will share the prize. The technology has now been given to millions of people around the world to protect them (2) ______ serious COVID-19.

The Nobel Prize committee said: "They contributed to the unprecedented (史无前例的) rate of vaccine (3) _____(develop) during one of the greatest threats to human health in modern times." Both (4) _____(tell) they had won by telephone this morning and were said to be (5) _____(amaze).

Vaccines train the immune (免疫的) system (6) _____(recognize) and fight threats such as viruses or bacteria. Traditional vaccine technology has been based on dead or weakened versions of the original virus or bacterium—or by (7) (use) elements of the infectious agent (传染性病原体).

In contrast, mRNA vaccines use a (8) _____(complete) different approach. During the Covid pandemic, the Moderna and Pfizer/BioNTech vaccines were both based on mRNA technology.

Professor Kariko and Professor Weissman met in the early 1990s (9) ______ they were working at the University of Pennsylvania, in the United States. At that time, (10) ______(they) interest in mRNA was considered unimportant in science.

China Belt and Road: Indonesia opens Whoosh high-speed railway

Indonesia has finished the construction of its first high-speed railway, a \$7.3bn (£5.9bn) project backed by China under its Belt and Road Initiative ("一带一路" 倡议). President Joko Widodo launched the service,

which connects the capital Jakarta to Bandung, a top (1) _____(economy) center.

The railway (2) _____(name) Whoosh. It can reach speeds of up to 350km/h(217mph) with the journey (3) _____(cover) 142 km.

Mr Widodo has prioritized (优先考虑) projects like Whoosh (4) _____(ease) the country's severe traffic jams. Indonesian officials say the high-speed railway is expected to improve economic productivity. The trains are powered (5) _____ electricity, which will help reduce the (6) _____(country) carbon footprint (碳排放量).

While ticket prices for the train have not been finalised, the company behind the train estimates that a oneway ticket could cost between 250,000 Indonesian rupiah (印尼卢比)(7)______ 350,000 Indonesian rupiah (\$16 to \$22.60). In comparison, a bus fare (公交车费) can cost as low as \$5, (8) ______ is approximately 77,685 Indonesian rupiah. And that difference can mean a lot for the average citizen.

The project is part of Chinese 10-year-old Belt and Road initiative, (9) _____ ambitious plan to connect Asia with Africa and Europe through a series of land and sea networks via investments.

Indonesia, South East Asia's largest economy, has been (10) _____(active) seeking investments from China, its largest trade partner.

Barbie overtakes Super Mario Bros to be 2023's biggest box office hit

Barbie (《芭比》) has officially become the year's biggest box office hit, after the doll's big-screen earnings overtook the *Super Mario Bros Movie*'s total (《超级马力欧兄弟大电影》).

The *Barbie* movie has now made \$1.38 bn (£1.1bn) (1) _____(global). That has taken it past the \$1.36bn taken (2) _____ the *Super Mario Bros Movie*.

Analysts did not expect cinemas to reach that milestone, (3) _____ the success of Barbenheimer—*Barbie* and Christopher Nolan's *Oppenheimer* (《奥本海默》), which (4) _____ (release) on the same day in July—propelled (驱动) takings past last (5) _____ (year) total of \$3.4bn (£2.7bn).

Many industry (6) _____(expert) also predicted that the *Super Mario Bros Movie* would be the biggest film of 2023. But *Barbie*, (7) (direct) by Greta Gerwig, has proved them wrong on that front too.

The Equalizer 3 (《伸冤人 3》), (8) _____(star) Denzel Washington, proved to be another summer hit on its release this weekend, taking \$34.5m (£27.3m) in its first three days at North American box offices.

However, there are concerns in Hollywood (9) _____ there may be a drop-off for rest of the year after films including *Dune: Part II* (《沙丘 2》), *Kraven the Hunter* (《猎人克莱文》) and the *Ghostbusters: Afterlife*

(《超能敢死队》) sequel (续集) moved their release dates to 2024, as the ongoing Hollywood strike (罢工) (10) _____(prevent) actors from promoting studio movies.

Land subsidence in Tianjin

On Thursday, it was initially decided that the land sinking in Tianjin's Jinnan district, which started on May

31, 2023, was caused by an unexpected natural ground issue, according to local news outlet Jinyun.

"Initial findings suggest that the unexpected natural ground issue was due to the (1) _____(complicate) geological structure deep underground. Based on the findings of scientific institutes, geologists suspect that there may be a geological hole about 1,300 meters underground, (2) _____ ordinary exploration was unable to discover," an expert told Jinyun. "We can't exclude the (3) _____ (possible) that geothermal well (地热井) drilling projects came into contact with the deep geological structure, resulting in even bigger disasters," the expert continued.

Between May 31 (4) ______ June 2, when the subsidence (地面沉降) was occurring at a rapid pace, some buildings (5) ______(affect). Between June 1 and 3, almost 3,900 residents of three high-rise residential buildings were moved to nearby hotels.
